**Patricia Hoban-Moore Named Interim CEO of YWCA Central Alabama**

**Birmingham, AL, February 2019** – The Board of Directors of YWCA Central Alabama selected Patricia Hoban-Moore to serve as the Interim Chief Executive Officer, effective February 2019. Hoban-Moore is a seasoned administrator in the public and nonprofit sectors. She attended undergraduate and graduate school at Wayne State University (Detroit), and holds a Master of Public Administration degree from the University of Georgia.

Since 1996, Hoban-Moore has served in several capacities of federal service in Washington, D.C. and the Southeastern United States. In her most recent position, she served as the General Deputy Assistant Secretary for Administration at HUD where she led all personnel, contracts, and support services for Headquarters and 65 field offices.

Pat is no stranger to the YW and its surrounding community. She is a Leadership Birmingham alumna, and served as a board member of the YW during her tenure as the CEO of the Jefferson County Housing Authority and HUD Official in Birmingham. Maggie Brooke, the YW's Board president, will welcome Ms. Hoban-Moore's return to the YW as the Interim CEO in mid-February.

"She was the perfect candidate for the job," said Board president Maggie Brooke. "She has all of the necessary skills and experience to handle our large and complex agency with many different programs and areas of service as we search for a permanent Chief Executive Officer."

Hoban-Moore follows former CEO Yolanda Sullivan, who retired in December 2018 after four years in the position, and more than 20 years of dedicated involvement as a volunteer, Board president and vice president of finance.
